**Bilingual Transitional & Housing Support Worker**  
**3.5 days/week**

Counselling and Family Service Ottawa is looking for a bilingual Transitional & Housing Support Worker to work in our VAW Program. Applicant should have a BSW with 3 years relevant experience or a MSW with at least 1 year relevant experience (or equivalent) working with women victims of partner abuse. The Transitional & Housing Support Worker will assist women and their children to live free of violence by providing practical assistance.

Working out of 2 locations, La Présence and CFS Ottawa (Olmstead St.), the caseworker will provide information and support, assistance with housing applications, support letters, support through the legal process, accompaniment to appointments and referrals to other relevant community resources. Candidates must have good knowledge of community resources, as well as an understanding of the issues facing vulnerable women and children. Bilingualism (English & French) is essential (verbal and written).

Must be able to work flexible hours, including evening hours. Membership in college (of social workers or psychotherapists) will be required. Travel off-site required.
